Decision concerning the twenty-second instalment of “E3” claims taken by the Governing Council of the
United Nations Compensation Commission at its 124th meeting, held on 12 December 2002

The Governing Council,

Having received, in accordance with article 38 of the Provisional Rules for Claims Procedure (“the Rules”), the report and recommendations made by the panel of Commissioners concerning the twenty-second instalment of “E3” claims, covering 13 claims, 1/

1. Approves the recommendations made by the panel of Commissioners, and, accordingly,
2. Decides, pursuant to article 40 of the Rules, to approve the amounts of the recommended awards concerning the claims covered in the report. The aggregate amounts awarded per country, based on the recommendations contained in table 49 of the report, are as follows:

3. Reaffirms that when funds become available payments shall be made in accordance with decision 100 (S/AC.26/Dec.100 (2000)/Rev.1),

4. Recalls that when payments are made in accordance with decision 100, and pursuant to the terms of decision 18 (S/AC.26/Dec.18 (1994)), Governments shall distribute amounts received to the designated claimants in respect of approved awards within six months of receiving payment, and shall, not later than three months after the expiration of this time limit, provide information on such distribution,

5. Requests the Executive Secretary to provide a copy of the report to the Secretary-General, to the Government of the Republic of Iraq and to each respective Government.
