Decision concerning the establishment of deadlines for the receipt of requests made pursuant to article 41 of the Provisional Rules for Claims Procedure taken by the Governing Council of the United Nations Compensation Commission at its 129th meeting, on 26 June 2003

The Governing Council,

Noting, the need to establish a final deadline for the receipt of requests made pursuant to article 41 of the Provisional Rules for Claims Procedure (“the Rules”) for correction of decisions concerning claims in categories “D”, “E” and “F”, to ensure the timely and orderly conclusion of the Commission’s claims processing activities,

Noting also, that a final deadline of 31 December 2002 was set in the case of such requests concerning claims in categories “A” and “C”,

1. Decides that the final date for the receipt of such requests for claims in categories “D”, “E” and “F” that have been approved by Governing Council decisions taken in or prior to June 2003 be set as 31 December 2003,

2. Decides also that the final date for the receipt of such requests for claims in categories “D”, “E” and “F” that will be approved by Governing Council decisions taken after June 2003 be set as 180 days after each such applicable Governing Council decision,

3. Decides that requests received after the relevant deadlines will not be considered by the Commission,

4. Requests Governments and international organizations to inform claimants in categories “D”, “E” and “F” of these deadlines.
