STATEMENT BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE GOVERNING COUNCIL OF THE UNITED NATIONS
COMPENSATION COMMISSION IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE DECISION CONCERNING THE
FIRST INSTALMENT OF "E2" CLAIMS (DOCUMENT S/AC.26/Dec.53 (1998)) MADE AT
THE 79TH MEETING OF THE GOVERNING COUNCIL, HELD ON 1 JULY 1998 AT GENEVA

In adopting the report and recommendations made by the Panel of
Commissioners concerning the first instalment of "E2" claims
(S/AC.26/1998/7), the Governing Council is conscious of the fact that the
recommendations were made on the basis of the particular facts of the four
cases included in the report.

The Governing Council reaffirms its important role in reviewing
future reports submitted by other panels of Commissioners so as to ensure
that the reports are prepared in a manner conforming with Security Council
resolution 687 (1991) and the pertinent Governing Council decisions.

Other panels should take this report into account while reviewing
claims in the light of the particular, relevant facts and circumstances.
